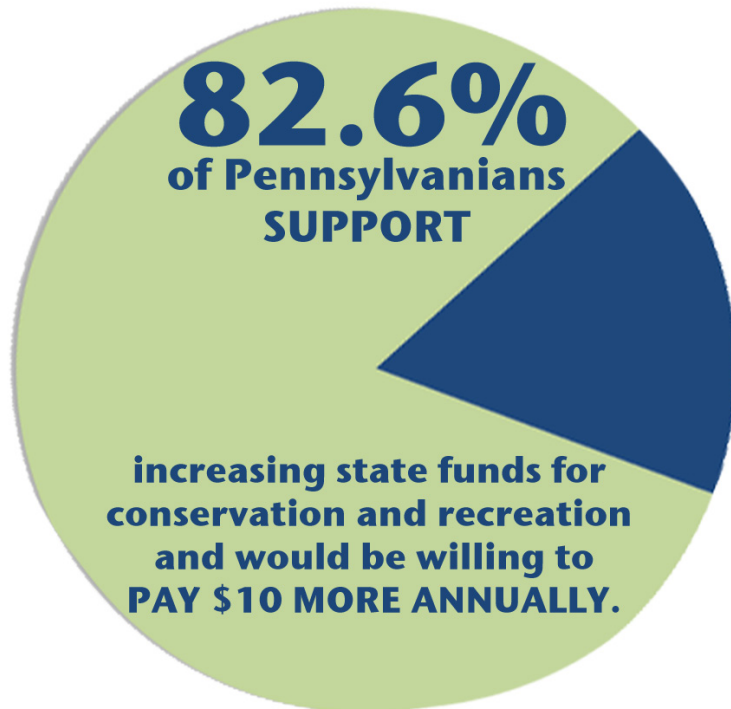

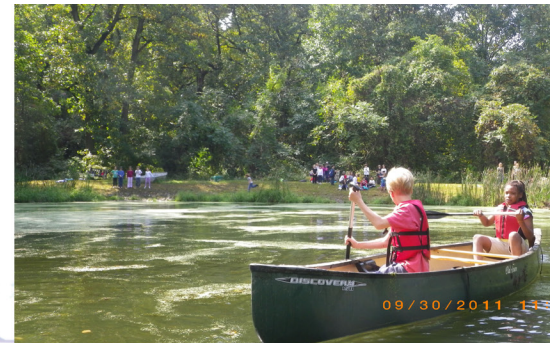
Each Keystone Fund dollar leverages **\$3.31** in **DIRECT** local investments in our parks, trails and community green space.

## With the Support of the Keystone Fund



**over 460 trails have been built and improved**



**over 136,000 acres, including greenways, parks and wildlife habitat, have been forever conserved**

**over 215 community libraries have been repaired and enhanced**



**over 570 historic buildings and sites have been restored and protected**



**nearly 2,100 community park development projects have been completed**



**120 state parks and 20 state forests are upgraded maintained so that they can welcome tens of millions of visitors each year**
