

## Maximizing Local Investments

**\$1.25 billion leveraged through public-private partnerships** to complete over 8,200 Keystone Fund projects.

Every dollar granted by the Keystone Fund leverages **\$3.13 in direct, local investments** in parks, trails, libraries, and community green spaces.

## Boosting the Outdoor Recreation Economy

Keystone Fund investments in community parks, trails, boat launches, and recreational facilities—along with major improvements at state parks and forests—all help drive Pennsylvania's **\$19 billion outdoor recreation economy**—the 8<sup>th</sup> largest in the nation.

In Pennsylvania, outdoor recreation supports **168,322 jobs** and generates **\$9 billion in wages**.

**Major upgrades** to state parks and forests accommodate the **40 million people who visit each year** and spend money at local establishments.

## Providing Cleaner, Safer Water & Flood Prevention

Land conserved through Keystone Fund generates an estimated \$2,825 per acre every year in water-related services—the equivalent of **\$533 million annually in stormwater mitigation, groundwater supply, water pollution reduction, and erosion prevention**. As a result, Pennsylvania communities have access to cleaner, safer water for drinking and recreation—and less threats from flooding.

## Supporting Places Where People Want to Live & Work

**99% of Pennsylvanians live within 5 miles of a Keystone Fund project site**—making safe, quality outdoor recreation available closer to home and contributing to more active, healthier communities.

By making tangible improvements to quality of life, the Keystone Fund projects draw employers and families who want to live and work nearby, **raising property values and tax revenue**.
