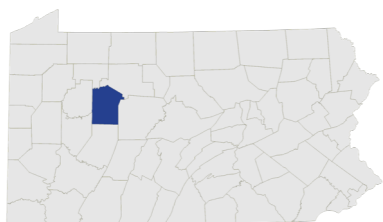

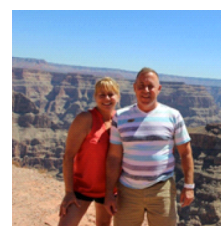


Something for Everyone
